

COTEAUX DU LANGUEDOC BLANC: LES MÛRIERS MAS BRUGUIÈRE

Style

White, Dry, Medium-bodied

Region

Languedoc Roussillon

Wine Maker

Xavier Bruguière

Appellation

Pic St Loup, 20 kilometres north of Montpellier in the Coteaux du Languedoc

Cépage

80% Marsanne and 20% Roussanne.

Tasting Note

A dry white wine displaying a very prominent nose, a rich palate with good balanced acidity and wonderful citric and tropical fruit flavours.

Serve with

Seafood or as an aperitif.

Cellarage

Drinks well from vintage but will age happily for 2-3 years.

Vinification

The grapes are picked at optimum ripeness and are matured on their lees for 5 months.

History

The Bruguière family have been making wine in Pic Saint-Loup since the Revolution and the 12-hectare estate is now run by Xavier and his wife, Marjorie. Mas Bruguière has 12 hectares of vines and has been at the forefront of Pic Saint Loup's rise to cru status. L'Arbouse is named after the strawberry tree that flourishes in the region.
