

# VAUCLUSE: LE PETIT CABOCHÉ

## Style

Red, Dry, Medium bodied

## Region

Southern Rhône

## Wine Maker

Jean-Pierre & Emily Boisson

## Appellation

Vin de Pays de Vaucluse, situated immediately north of Avignon

## Cepage

100% Grenache

## Tasting Note

Aromas of red fruit precede a palate of blackcurrants and raspberries with soft, supple tannins and a clean finish

## Serve

On its own or with Pasta, Charcuterie

## Cellarage

Drink within 2-5 years of vintage.

## Vinification

The grapes are picked at optimum maturity and are partly crushed prior to fermentation in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats. The wine is then aged in wood before being fined, filtered and bottled.

## History

For generations the Boisson family had been both wine makers and blacksmiths. Jean-Pierre's mother helped establish an interest in wine which subsequently led to him becoming a wine maker. The Petit Caboche is Jean-Pierre's latest brainchild and is grown from vines in the Vaucluse where three quarters of the wine produced is red. The family nickname of Caboche derives from the old Provençal word for 'horseshoe nails'.
