A classic bouquet of violets and petits fruits rouges precedes a charming palate of subtle game, stone fruit and earthy flavours offset by ripe tannins.

Small game, grilled meats or semi-soft cheeses.

## Cellarage

Approachable when young, especially if decanted, this will age well for 5-10 years in superior vintages.

## Vinification

Hand-harvested grapes from 60 year-old vines on the 'Rue aux Porcs' climat

## History

Stéphane Brocard is a branché thirty-something Chablisien who found his family's wine business becoming crowded when working alongside his brother and sister-in-law and sister and brother-in-law. An intimate knowledge of Burgundy and a hankering to do his own thing led him to set up a boutique négociant business contracting in small parcels of carefully selected grapes, as well as investing in a precious plot of Pommard, for which he has high aspirations.
